

## 2016 Nagoya Sister City Art Exchange

**The Nagoya Sister City Art Exchange is an exhibition opportunity offered by the Arts Unit for all students of NSW Public Schools K-12.**

The Entry nominations for 2016 Nagoya Sister City Art exchange are due by Friday 29 July.

The Exhibition will feature outstanding art works from NSW Public schools and will be an excellent showcase for Visual Arts Programs in our public schools.

The Nagoya Sister City Art Exchange is held annually. The artworks selected are exhibited in Nagoya, Japan along with works by students in Nagoya, Sydney, Los Angeles, Mexico City, Turin and Nanjing. Students' works selected for the Nagoya Sister City Art Exchange will not be returned. The students will receive a certificate celebrating their artwork's selection. Your school/students will receive artworks from Japan in exchange.

Students receive recognition by participating in an exhibition such as this. It also provides a wonderful opportunity for students to participate in international friendship and cultural exchange activities, which in turn promotes the further development of sister city relationships

I invite you to nominate a maximum of 4 outstanding student artworks, K-12, that would be suitable for consideration for the "Nagoya Sister City Art Exchange" please contact me by mail or email using the nomination form attached.

### **Entry Conditions**

All works submitted for nomination in the Nagoya Art Exchange are required to meet the following requirements:

- Artworks must be NO SMALLER than A4 (210mm x 297mm) and NO LARGER than A3 (420mm x 297mm) in size. Works that are outside these dimensions cannot be accepted for exhibitions.
- Framed or mounted artworks or artworks on a stretched canvas will not be accepted.
- Artworks with earthy matter e.g. sand, feathers etc will not be selected due to export regulations.
- Artworks may be horizontal (landscape) or vertical (portrait).
- Student artists must be enrolled at a public school in New South Wales in any class from Kindergarten to Year 12 in the year of entry and the artwork must solely be the work of the student or group of students.
- The nomination forms need to be accompanied by a colour photo (standard or digital) of the nominated artwork. Photos of all the pieces of a Body of Work only need to be sent. **Do not** send the actual artwork.
- The photos of the nominated artworks will be viewed by a selection panel for inclusion of the artworks in the exhibition. The decisions of the selection panel are final.
- Schools will be informed by August 8 of the successful nominations.
- Successful nominated artwork is then due by August 26

**Closing date for nominations is Friday July 29**
